

- ~300 employees and growing.


SSM activates – new nuclear power

- Science grants
 - Grants to sustain and build national competence
- International cooperation
 - Competence building
 - Simplifies future leveraging of reviews
- Studies to prepare regulatory standpoints with regard to review questions needed to be resolved
- Regulation on specific topics
- Licencing process development

- Main objective be ready to review applications in 2025
 - Guidance to and dialog with potential applications
 - Development of our management system
- Developing a pre-licence process
 - Report submitted to the government on suggested scope
 - Ensuring a process is in place if we get a mandate for a pre-licence process

Guidance on application content

- Recently published
 - Describes content and purpose for each application
- Starting point for a dialog
- Introduces our concept of proven and non-proven technology
- Introduces plan for construction and commissioning
